ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

KLR600 / KLR700 / KLR800 / KLR900

Please read these instructions carefully before assembly (and sometimes even during planning). The assembly of all PHOS products can be carried out taking into account the relevant assembly instructions. We recommend that you carry out the installation with at least two people. For all work, ensure sufficient freedom of movement and a safe stand. We supply high-quality assembly material for our products, which is suitable for most fastenings. However, depending on the nature of the substrate, a special solution may also be necessary. Before installation, check the subsurface professionally (e.g. for strength, stability, condition, running lines, heating systems, etc.), improper installation can lead to accidents. Please use commercially available and suitable tool. See the assembly instructions for a list of the tools required. When using power tools, you should wear safety goggles and follow the manufacturer's safety instructions. If in doubt, contact a specialist.

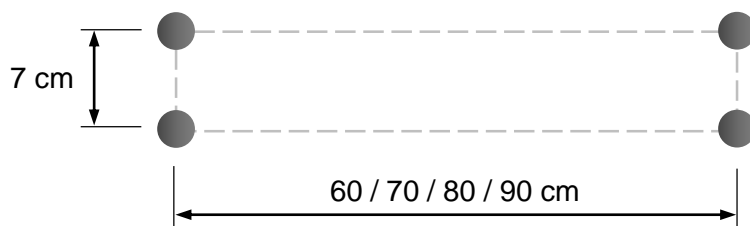

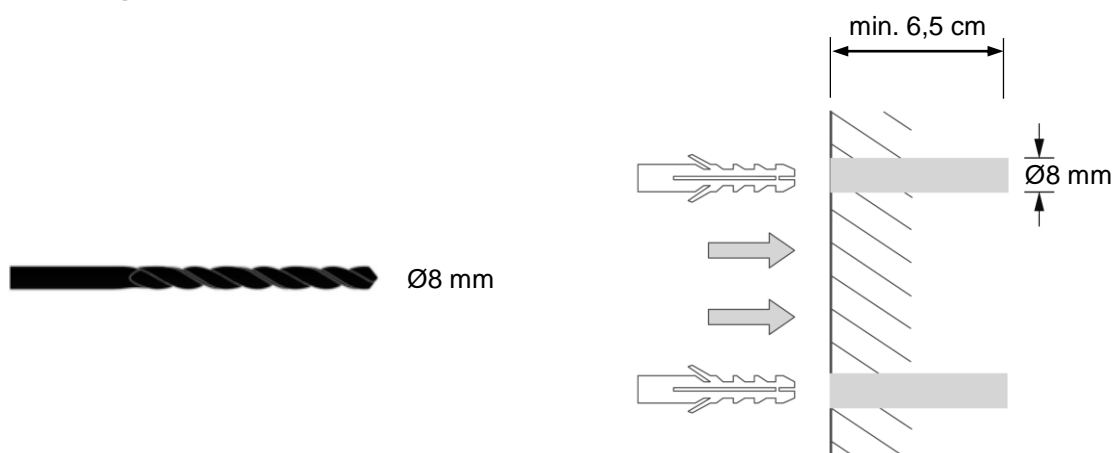

Position of the holes



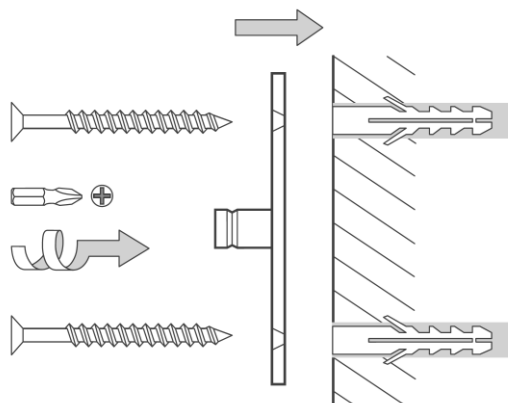

4x Drilling and 4x Dowels

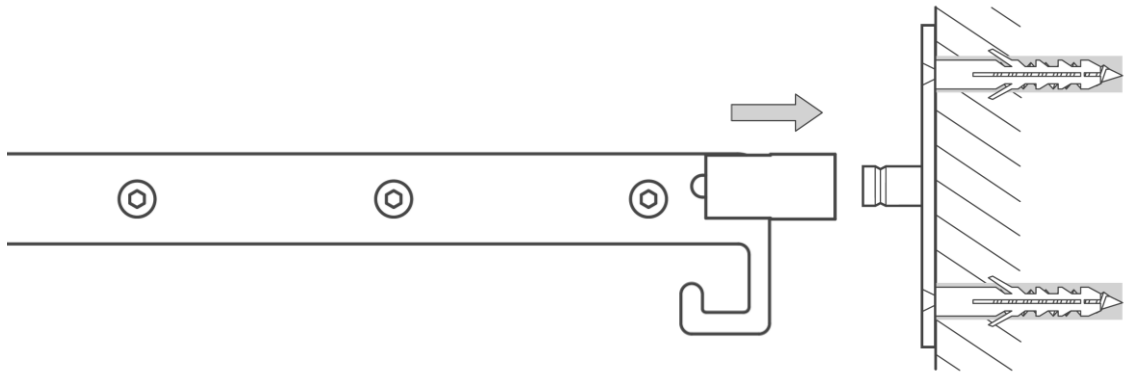

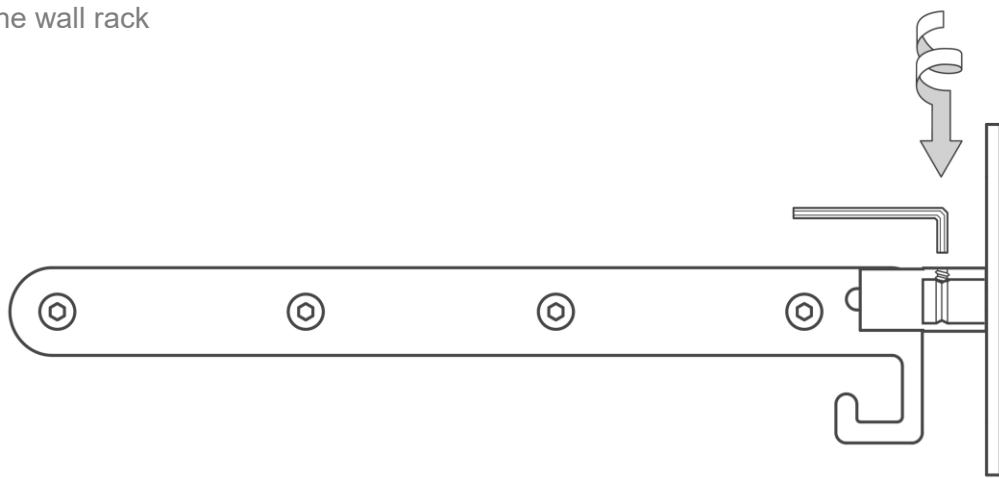
Screw 2x mounting rosettes to the wall
